# Marching On: Mangalarga

Have you ever discovered something so exciting and fun (like riding gaited horses), that you want to share it with everyone? Now imagine speeding along in the latest luxury sports car convertible with the top down, and enjoying a ride so comfortable that you barely realize how fast you are going! Next think about all the things you like to do on horseback - pleasure, trail, endurance, dressage, jumping, polo, cattle round-ups and cutting. Is there one horse breed that's so versatile and can do all of this? As a matter of fact, there is! The Mangalarga Marchador Horse from Brazil, a solid and sturdy breed, classic of its Iberian Heritage.

Who are these Mangalarga Marchadores, known as the national horse of Brazil? Once you get the rhythm, it's easy to pronounce, "Manga-larga-Marcha-dot", or Marchadores as the American's like to say. Sharing a history with other Iberian breeds, this 200-year-old breed

was developed by crossing the Andalusian, Lusitano and the Barb. This produced a horse known for its rhythmic smooth gaits, sensible intelligence, docile temperament, and amazing stamina that is hardy and adaptable to all climates, feed and terrains.

To appreciate the unique attributes that makes the Marchador Horse breed special, some understanding of the characteristic gaits is needed. In addition to the walk, canter, and gallop, there are two long reaching four beat gaits. This is the only horse breed in the world that can perform on a lateral and diagonal. The ability to perform both movements makes this breed a joy to work and a pleasure to ride.

So what's different about these gaits? While there are similarities with

other gaits breeds, it's the four beat extended reach in front, propelled from behind, that is stabilized by triple hoof support.

While there are currently only twenty-eight Marchador horses in the United States, with more to come beginning this spring, you may have seen them on TV, marching in the New Year's Pasadena Rose Parade, Western Horse Expo, Southern Horse Expo, Equine Affairs (Ohio, Massachusetts, California) or Equitana. "It's our mission to establish this wonderful breed in the United States along with the many other Spanish breeds that we enjoy". Maesha Sielbeck, president of the Mangalarga Marchador Horse Association of America states, "The high standards set by the Brazilian Association (ABCCMM) will be maintained and the foundation breeding stock will be carefully

**MARCHA PICADA** - four beat gait characterized by lateral leg movements, with the sequence of the hoofs being: right rear, right front, left rear, left front; the hind foot touching the ground a fraction of a second before the front foot. The continuous triple hoof support and the over-reach of the hind foot, makes the gait very smooth. This differs from "the trace" which is an exclusively lateral movement in the limbs, where the two legs on the same side (hind and hind leg) go up at the same time as the other side goes down, which results in only half of the horse's body mass being set on the ground at each time of movement. At extended speed the head and body lift up like a speed boat in front to create a "plane-like" sensation that makes you feel like you aren't moving.

**MARCHA BATIDA** - leg moving in a diagonal four beat sequence, also with moments of triple hoof support. Although some ways similar, this gait differs from the not suspended moment of all the legs in the air as the horse is always in contact with the ground. The longer and more frequent the moments of triple hooves support, the more comfortable is the gait. Although different entirely, this movement allows the horse to be taught to trot easily, therefore enabling the horse to perform events such as dressage (Olympic Level), where trotting is a must.






### Orixá Vale Vermelho do Regal
