Exhibition of the Breed

Theresa Longo has a dream of creating a professional exhibition of the Mangalarga Marchador breed available to do world-class shows such as Equine Affaire or the Fiesta of the Spanish Horse. California is a great place as many expos are there! The act she envisions is an 8 horse Marchador drill team. She needs 4 additional horses from anyone wishing to showcase their horse or share in showcasing the breed.

To create the choreography, the costumes and train the horses and riders, horses need to be at Rancho de los Cielos for some time as the shows require a videotaped dress rehearsal performance in early 2008. The drill team will perform maneuvers as a group and as pairs. Costuming will include half the riders in pants and half in skirts. The music will be a piece called "Brazilian Flamenco" that has both light-hearted and melodramatic Theresa is the choreographer; Diane Lindholm is the trainer. Diane has ridden drill team and trained drill teams before. If multiple ranches participate, there would be an opportunity to add judged classes as well at the events.
