MEMBERS

- 2017 83 members; 111 members so far in 2022 with the membership drive still going on closing in April. Members can still join at any time.
- 23 Lifetime members also a new high. 134 members total.
- Looking for more programs and opportunities to support members in 2022 (and always)

FINANCIALS

- Started 2021 with \$13,682; Ended the year with \$12,427 with another \$850 award money being granted, but not yet paid by December 31, 2021.
- Annual Operating budget about \$5-7,000 a year, funded by membership dues and registry fees.
- Income in \$5,595; Spending -\$6,850 Significant expenditures are Software/Computer - 37% for website, constant contact etc), Membership Awards - 26% and UC DAVIS DNA - 20%. The rest is spent on miscellaneous (insurance, postage, PayPal fees etc.),
- \$5,000 savings account is not available for annual spending. It represents our lifetime members contributions which are designated to cover a minimum of 10 years. We allocate the funds accordingly.
